

## Power Hour Program

Dear Parents and Guardians:

Our club offers mandatory homework time for all of our school aged kids in the afternoon. We have been evaluating this program for opportunities to improve its impact on our members.

Currently we have the kids do their homework as soon as they get off the bus. We understand that they are in school sitting all day and then riding the bus for a long length of time. We also understand that it is not easy for the kids to come and do homework as soon as they come in to the club and they need time to burn off some energy.

With the goal of improving this program, for the next two weeks we will be testing out a new homework time. We will now be allowing the kids to come in and have a “free time” if they choose before they go and do their homework.

- Homework will still be a mandatory and important piece to our afterschool program.
- Homework will continue to be open until 6pm or until the last kid leaves.
- To help you and the staff know that your child went into the homework room each child will receive a stamp for when they get their homework done. We will also have a different stamp for when they go in and say they have no homework.
